Sub: Bihar Floods 2008

This is in follow up of our telephone conversation this evening on the Bihar flood situation. We value the significant contributions made by the Bharatiya Jain Sanghatana in the devastating natural disasters in the country in the past. As discussed, the requirements for providing relief to the flood affected people include:

the provision of temporary shelter materials like

family tents, tarpaulin sheets, CGI sheets,

and 500 litre water tanks

and water purification plants.

The National Disaster Management Authority has already mobilized about 4,000 tents, 200,000 water bottles and 2 crores of halogen tablets, apart from 84 motorised boats for search and rescue and these have been dispatched to the flood affected districts.

I would appreciate it very much if you can let me know the plans of Bharatiya Jain Sanghatana (BJS) to respond to the Bihar floods in terms of the provision of the required relief items.
